

CONTROL CLUB'S DRASTIC NEW RULE.

The Billiard Association for the government of the game has there been such a sensation—so many law-abiding men are concerned as that caused by an announcement made yesterday by the Central Club that no entry from licensed victuallers, or from anybody connected with them, would be accepted for the club's new membership.

No man will entries be accepted from a man who is employed as a waiter, a barman, or a clerk by billiard-table purveyors, or from any firm supplying billiard requisites.

The pronouncement regarding the licensed victuallers' trade reads as follows:—"Any man or any one employed by a licensed house, or a licensed house in which a billiard table is situated, is not eligible."

CUT AT "THE TRADE."
